French Language Arts Program:

A big focus across all grade levels in French as a Second Language is oral communication. Please encourage your child to share with you the vocabulary and songs we are learning in class. This will help them gain confidence in speaking French and develop an interest in learning the language. We will also be writing, listening, and reading throughout the year! I encourage your child to practice French outside of the classroom.

French Social Studies Program:

This year in Grade 2 Social Studies, students will be focusing on **Changing Family and Community Traditions**, and **Global Communities**.

Montre et Raconte (Show and Tell):

Students really enjoy bringing items in for Show and Tell and showing them to classmates. It provides a great opportunity for the students to speak French in class. In the next couple of weeks, I will start sending home a letter telling you when it will be your child's turn for "Montre et Raconte". The letter will go home the week before your child is to present, in order to give him/her time to choose a special item they would like to bring in as well as practice the simple French sentences they will use for their presentation.



Homework:

Any stories, vocabulary, or songs we are working on in class will be sent home with the English homework folder. Your child is asked to practice at home. Also any unfinished work will be sent home for homework.
